In June we will be contacting you via telephone to confirm your subject choices. At that point we will then be able to issue you with a pack of bridging work via Teams. This will enable you to undertake some preparatory learning that will support your transition into post 16 studies. This will help you to consolidate your prior learning and will give you a fantastic head start for the curriculum content required for your chosen A levels or Level 3 courses.
